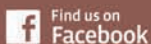

Fully restored with great interactive displays and facilities, you can enjoy the accessible house and the lovely garden in the delightful setting of Southampton's Old Town.

The house dates back to the 1400s, and celebrated its centenary as a museum in 2012. It has a fascinating history, lived in by the rich, the famous and the poor, from the Tudor Lord Chief Justice Sir Richard Lyster to the Victorian milliner Eliza Simmons. Find out more about these characters' stories as you explore the house.

The displays include recently restored items never before shown, as well as much loved favourites. Schools and adult groups can book tours and workshops – from an hour to a whole day.

- Experience an exciting film and light show introducing the fascinating history of the house.
- Encounter the people who lived in the house through the free audio guides.
- Discover state of the art technology revealing the layers of Tudor House's rich history.
